### Yearbook Pricing Guide

- Early Bird: \$65 (Due by Oct. 23)
- Oct. 24 - April 30: \$70
- May 1 until last day of school year if available to pre-order: \$80
- Distribution in August: \$80 (if extras are available)

**Book Sales Policy:** Any customer who does not wish to keep his/her book may obtain a refund provided that the book is returned in the same condition in which it was distributed. Once returned, the book becomes the property of the staff and can be resold at the current cost. Exchanges can be made for books with minor flaws if no writing has been done in the book. If a book has been written in, then no exchange can be made unless the adviser feels the flaw in the book is of major proportion (pages missing, pages upside down, etc.). It will be the responsibility of the buyer to provide proof of purchase if no record can be provided by the staff. A canceled check or receipt will constitute proof of purchase. Books not claimed at the end of the first semester of classes in the fall automatically become the property of the yearbook staff and can be sold at the current price.
